

Recycled Regatta Rules

- 1) 70% of boat materials should be recycled
- 2) 30% of the materials can be new (tape, especially duct tape, contact paper string or rope)
- 3) Boats can be made of cardboard, milk jugs, water bottles, soft drink bottles, plastic wrap, etc.
- 4) Boats cannot be made of wood
- 5) Boats cannot be made from flotation devices – no old surfboards or boogie boards
- 6) Any Styrofoam must be securely contained or sealed so it cannot break loose
- 7) Must paddle, peddle, or use sail power – no swimming alongside or pushing or pulling using the creek bottom
- 8) All participants must wear a US Coast Guard approved life vest and sign a waiver race day
